The Budo Uniform - Gi

The complete budo uniform consists of a so-called GI or DOGI, which is a white judo or karate suit. It includes a white or coloured belt, the OBI.

To tie the belt is always a problem for beginners. Here you can learn how the belt is attached properly. Try it out. Over and over again. Just do not give up! \odot



Picture 1:

Fold the belt once in the middle.

(Note: If you don't start exactly in the middle, the ends will hang down in unequal length finally.)



Picture 2:

The center of the belt is placed on the abdomen. Bring the two ends behind your back and swap them between your hands.



Picture 3:

Then bring the ends on the other side to the front again.



Picture 4:

The left end of the belt is placed over the right end.



Picture 5:

Now pull the left end between the belt and the uniform upwards from the bottom.

(Note: it must get behind <u>both</u> layers of the belt.)



Picture 6:

The end that hangs out from above, is placed over the lower end.



Picture 7:

Wrap the lower end around the top. Now you got your knot.



Picture 8:

Pull belt firmly...
