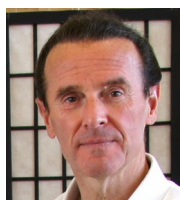
we are glad to welcome Hiroshi Akamine Sensei from Okinawa - the homeland of Karate and Kobudo - in Germany for the fifth time. He will be assisted as always by Sensei Dell Hamby and – for the first time – by Sensei Paul Vermiglio.



Kaicho Hiroshi Akamine is the grandson of Raisuke Higa, a Yamani Ryu Bo-Jutsu legend, and son of the distinguished Master Eisuke Akamine. He started training under his father in 1960 as a child at the age of 6. Eight years later he studied also under Shinken Taira Sensei. In 1970, his father sent him to study Karate under Shijin Gushiken. Akamine Sensei was awarded teacher's license in Karate by Eisuke Akamine Sensei (1987) and by Gushiken Sensei (1994). 1999 he was awarded teacher's license in Kobudo by Eisuke Akamine Sensei. He was the 3rd president in the lineage of the Ryukyu Kobudo Hozon Shinko Kai after Shinken Taira Sensei and Eisuke Akamine Sensei. In July 2011 he founded his own new kobudo organization 'Ryukyu Kobudo Shimbukan'. Highly ranked in both Kobudo and Karate (Hanshi 9th Dan) with more than 50 years of practice he is renowned for his expertise in speed and development of tanden energy.



Sensei Paul Vermiglio started with martial arts at the age of 13. His main influencing teachers are Andy Sherry, Bob Poynton, Frank Brennen, Grandmaster Eisuke Akamine, Yukio Kuniyoshi, Hidemi Tamayose, Don Shapland and his current sensei Kaicho Hiroshi Akamine. With an experience of 44 years practice (20 years Ju-Jitsu, 44 years Kobudo, 26 years Karate) he today holds a 4th Dan in Ju-Jitsu and 7th Dan Kyoshi both in Karate and Kobudo. Paul Sensei is one of the worldwide highest ranked masters of our organization.



Sensei Dell Hamby began training Shotokan in 1988 in Switzerland and received 3rd Dan in 1995. His interests in the origins of karate led him to Okinawa for the first time in 1996 where he began training Uechi Ryu Karate under Sensei Shigeru Takamiyagi. Since then Dell Hamby visited Okinawa every year for several weeks. There he began training kobudo in 1999 under Sensei Shigeo Izumi and later under Kaicho Hiroshi Akamine. Meanwhile he holds a 6th Dan Renshi both in Uechi Ryu Karate-Do and in Ryukyu Kobudo. In 2016 he moved to Okinawa where he is living now. His seminars are characterized by a clear, powerful execution of technics and a stirring, motivating teaching.

The seminar is open to everybody - beginners as well as experienced practitioners - regardless of style, affiliation or rank.

With this seminar we also celebrate the 20 years anniversary of our Ki-Shin-Tai Dojo Erlangen.

SEMINAR CONTENTS:

You will see an introduction into the Ryukyu Kobudo Shimbukan syllabus. No previous knowledge will be required. For advanced participants we will work through the grading system from Kyu to 6th Dan.

The seminar will be ordered methodically. For kobudo beginners and participants who are not well known with our kobudo style we recommend to attend classes from thursday morning on. Advanced students as well as beginners may participate in the seminar. The group will be split and taught separately according to rank and knowledge.

For Ryukyu Kobudo Shimbukan members it will be possible to take part in Dan examinations on sunday. Therefor a pre-registration (please ask for the registration form and fees) is required. Payment of the examination fees in YEN (cash) directly to Akamine sensei on the place.
